- 20 Vet Care Grants to Cats

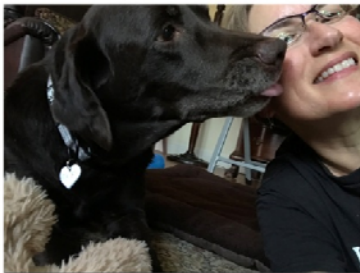
PET FOOD PROGRAM
